The Problem

- Refugees are forced to flee their countries due to internal strife
- When they reach safer neighboring countries they can often experience further strife
- Refugees are often
 - Discriminated against
 - Treated inhumanely
 - Not protected from violence
 - Housed in subpar shelters

The Problem Part 2

- Refugees are often encouraged to abandon their cultures
- It is very difficult to gain asylum
 - It can be a lengthy process
 - Requirements are often very strict
 - Processing centers are often underfunded
- Even after gaining asylum they can easily be deported
