Committee Procedures

Attendance:

- Present Declares your presence in the committee
- Present & Voting Declares your presence and affirms that you will vote

Motion:

A formal call for action

Parliamentary Etiquette:

- Know when to speak
- Know how to ask for assistance (point of personal inquiry)

Caucuses

Moderated Caucus:

- Declared through a motion which determines the speaking time and topic
- Countries can volunteer to provide a speech within the allotted speaking time
- The chair will select a list of volunteering countries to speak
- Takes the form of a formal debate

Unmoderated Caucus:

- Declared through a motion which determines the time of the caucus
- Delegates are allowed to work as they please within the time
 - Informal debates
 - Work on papers
 - Form blocks (alliances)

Speaking Tips

Begin Speeches with:

- "Thank you honorable chair and esteemed delegates..."

If you finish early end with:

- "Thank you, I yield the rest of my time for the chair."

Use inclusive pronouns:

- You are not a person but a country's representative

Use facts to support your speech Speak with confidence
